For Students

Every course is divided into five components of reading, listening to audio lectures, writing, memorization and having a discussion/dialog session with an approved facilitator.

Students have to be willing to engage in rigorous self-study and attend dialog sessions with a facilitator.

STATEMENT OF FAITH
